Standards for Excellence Training Offered To Local Nonprofit Organizations

MOUNDSVILLE, WV – The Marshall County Family Resource Network is hosting a Standards for Excellence Clinic Series in November. The Standards for Excellence program is an initiative dedicated to strengthening management and governance in nonprofit organizations. The centerpiece for the program is a code of conduct for well managed, responsibly governed nonprofits called Standards for Excellence: An Ethics and Accountability Code for the Nonprofit Sector. The standards program is designed to promote excellence and integrity in nonprofit management and to strengthen the public's trust in nonprofit organizations.

The clinic series will cover the eight major topic areas in the Standards for Excellence in detail. These sessions are designed to help you learn how to use the standards to assess and improve your organization's mission, governance, financial systems, personnel practices, fundraising, legal and compliance issues, conflicts of interest and public policy and public affairs.
